FACTS ABOUT SUICIDE

- Over 33,000 people in the US die by suicide every year.
- Suicide accounted for the deaths of 162 Kitsap residents in the five year period between 2004 and 2008.
- In Kitsap County suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for people 15-34 years of age and 10th leading cause for all ages.
- Across Washington State there are more suicide deaths than deaths from motor vehicle crashes.
- People of all ages, classes, and ethnic backgrounds are impacted by suicide.

Survivors of Suicide (SOS) is made possible by caring volunteers who coordinate and facilitate monthly meetings. All survivors who can benefit from the group are welcomed.
